100 WOMEN MAKING A DIFFERENCE!

Dear Friends in Christ,

We **PRAISE AND THANK GOD** that He continues to use the Titus Women's Ministry (TWM) in bringing women into the experience of heart holiness through Bible studies, retreats/summits, conferences and other activities! We also **THANK YOU** for your financial support and prayers that help us to go forward with the vision God has for this ministry! We are filled with excitement as God leads us into new areas of reaching women who have a deep desire for a closer relationship with Him. As a friend of our ministry, we are inviting you to be part of our **2009 Challenge – 100 Women Making a Difference!**

The Year 2008 was designated as a year of strategic prayer with TWM sponsoring its first **Lydia Prayer Conference**. One hundred women from eighteen states, eleven denominations and four countries came together on February 7-9, 2008, at St. Simons Island, Georgia to seek God for revival. We praise God for meeting these women in a powerful way as they prayed and shared together around His Word. Following the conference, there was a greater than ever burden placed on our hearts to find a way to mobilize prayer for revival on behalf of our nation.

In response to the above burden, the **Lydia Lifeline** was created in 2008 to challenge women from across the country to pray daily for revival in America. Ninety women signed up to be a part of this undertaking. These women are being supported by TWM through a monthly e-mail that provides a prayer focus, along with other helpful information and guidance, as women pray corporately or individually for revival. Our plans are to continue on indefinitely with the Lifeline.

The **Lydia Prayer Groups** are continuing to form throughout the U.S., as well as abroad. We are thrilled as to how God is using the Lydia Prayer Group Ministry for women to experience the incredible power of prayer and to be encouraged to live daily in the fullness of His Holy Spirit. Within a short period of time, approximately 120 Lydia Prayer Groups have been organized in 29 states and in countries such as: Kenya, Hungary and Vanuatu, Pacific Islands. Within these groups, women are being challenged to pray for revival in their families, their churches, their communities and our nation. Also, beyond this, each month the groups focus their prayers on a different part of the world. A new Lydia Prayer Journal was published last year and is being used by the Lydia Prayer Groups, along with the Lydia Prayer Guide which is in its third printing, and other resources provided by TWM. Our prayer is to have two Lydia Prayer Leaders in each state to support, encourage and be a resource for the Lydia Prayer Groups in their state.

The **Standing in the Gap E-News** will continue to be used by TWM to unite the hearts and minds of women around the world with Scripture, personal prayer and prayer for the world. This also was a very useful instrument in fulfilling God's plan for us to make 2007, 2008 and now 2009 a year of prayer for revival for the nation and the world. This weekly E-News is being sent to over 250 women and includes information such as: the scripture of the week, a personal devotion, TWM updates, upcoming retreats, summits and conferences, specific prayer requests for our monthly world focus and other prayer requests that cover a broad range of personal and global concerns and interests.

The increasing receptivity to God's message of the Holy Heart through Come to the Fire Conferences, the Lydia Prayer Conference and Titus Retreats/Summits has made us more aware than ever of the crucial necessity and privilege of follow-up, nurturing and discipling these hearts to go forward in victorious living! After much prayer, the TWM Board believed God was asking us to establish a fellowship of women mentors throughout the nation, who not only live the reality of a Holy Heart, but desire to understand with clarity and anointing the message of proclaiming the Word and teaching other women. In response to God's bidding, on November 20-22, 2008, the TWM sponsored a **Leadership Summit** at the Inn at The Amish Door in Wilmot, Ohio, where women came together for a concentrated study of His Word, interaction and prayer on Holy-Hearted Living.

God is also laying a burden on our hearts to encourage women to mentor and teach children and young people about the Holy Heart. In response to this burden the next **Titus Discipleship Summit** is taking on this theme, "Holy Hearts for the Next Generation." The Summit will be held April 22-24, 2010 at the same location in Wilmot, Ohio. We also believe that Jesus is leading the ministry of Titus to include a children's branch providing materials, resources and opportunities for children and youth to learn about the Holy Heart and to participate in our Lydia Prayer Ministry. Would you pray with us about God's leading in this area?

Again, Women Alive Ministries, located in Kansas City, MO, will be partnering with TWM, and other women's ministries, for the fourth **Come to the Fire Conference** to be held in Nashville, Tennessee on November 12-14, 2009.
