Titus Women's Ministry is a fellowship of Christian women who are committed to the purpose of spreading the message of the Holy Heart to women by means of teaching and modeling the incredible joy of knowing Jesus Christ personally and loving Him with ALL their heart, soul, mind and strength through the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit.

How Do I Become a Titus Woman?

Step 1: Join a Bible Study (*growing in my personal relationship*)



The purpose of Titus Women's Bible Study is for me and other women to get into the experience of holiness of heart. At Bible Study I will receive teaching and training to help me grow personally in my love relationship with Jesus and my walk with God so that I can become a "mother in the faith," reproducing the life of Jesus in the lives of others beginning in my home with my husband and children and then sloshing over to others. I want to become a Titus woman —

- a spirit-filled woman who can rightly divide the word of truth,
- who can pray,
- and who can lead others into a love relationship with Jesus Christ.

At Bible Study I will learn how to come into a personal love relationship with Jesus Christ, to die to my self-will, and to become filled with the Spirit.

Step 2: Lydia Prayer Group (*getting deeper in the Word*)

Lydia Prayer Groups will help me as a part of my training in learning to pray and getting deeper into the Word. In my prayer group I will —

- learn to pray and share my heart needs with others,
- learn to pray for others,
- learn to pray out loud.

Step 3: Discipleship and Leadership Training (*life-to-life transference and instruction — learning how to pray, how to lead prayer, how to have intercessory prayer, and how to have conversational prayer*)

In discipleship and leadership training I will have the opportunity to

- meet in small groups learning accountability and life-to-life sharing,
- train in inductive Bible studies offered during J-term or during the summer,
- train in spiritual reproduction—how I can lead someone to Jesus,
- train in leading someone to be filled with the Spirit,
- train in how to lead children to Jesus.

Step 4: Outreach (*encouragement to use the tools that God has given me to reach out to my family, my neighborhood, my church, and my community*)

Some of the "sloshing over" effects from Bible Study, from my Lydia Prayer Group, and from Discipleship and Leadership Training are —

- ministering within the body of Bible study and outside the body of Bible study,
- member care (such as welcoming new people in the town),
- providing meals during sickness,
- helping with babysitting,
- conducting Bible studies in nursing homes, halfway houses, and other places where needed
