

Lydia Prayer Suggestions #9

Proclaim God's Glory: "Thank you, God, that you are the Source of all steadfastness and encouragement. You are Compassionate and Merciful, the Lord of the whole world. You are: El-Shaddai – The All Sufficient One, Jahweh-Shalom – The Lord is Peace, Jahweh-Jireh – The Provider, Jahweh-Ropheka – The Lord who Heals! Jesus, thank you for salvation! You are the Way, the Truth, the Life, Christ the Hope of glory, Counselor, Holiness, Love, Power, Wisdom, the King of Kings, and my Redeemer!"

Seek the King's Glory through Holiness: Allow God to guide you through the following questions:

- Is there any unconfessed sin in my life?
- Do I have unforgiveness and bitterness in my life?
- Are there any doubtful practices or activities in my life?
- Am I always obeying the Holy Spirit promptly and confessing Jesus unashamedly?

Seek the King's Glory through the Salvation of the Lost: Pray for five unsaved families or friends. Pray for their salvation, that God will bless them spiritually, socially, emotionally, and pray for their needs.

Seek the King's Glory in the Church:

1. For congregations to be restored as houses of prayer for all nations. (Matthew 21:13)
2. For congregations that fulfill the Great Commission. (Matthew 28:18-20)
3. For congregations that fulfill the Great Commandment. (Matthew 22:37-40)
4. For spiritual revival in the church.
5. For a church that will be faithful to the Word and relevant in addressing needs of the people.

Seek the King's Glory as you Pray for Your Personal Needs:

Bring your needs boldly to God's throne. List them. Be specific.

Seek the King's Glory by Watching and Listening to Him: Ask the Lord to reveal new things to you, things that He wants you to notice, things to which He wants you to pay attention. Ask Him to reveal His will and strategies and plans to you. Ask Him for things that are on His heart about which He wants you to pray. Write down in your prayer journal what you sense He is saying to you.

Seek the King's Glory in the Nations:

- Pray that the nations will see that Christ Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. (John 14:6)
- Pray that the unreached peoples of the earth will be reached with the gospel.
- Pray for the coming of God's peace and glory to countries and nations.
- Pray that kings and governments will submit to the Lordship of Jesus as the King of Kings.

Seek the King's Glory by breaking strongholds of evil and by Repenting of any involvement in:

Immorality, witchcraft, idolatry, racial hatred, ethnic pride, injustices, and ungodly covenants

Seek the King's Glory through His intervention and breakthroughs in global challenges:

The persecuted church in many nations, wars, ethnic violence, millions of refugees

Seek the King's Glory by Touching the Youth:

- Pray that this generation of young people will reach their generation with the gospel.
- Pray for radical, committed disciples living in holiness.
- Pray for young people to come into an intimacy with God, and they will serve, obey, and follow Him with compassionate hearts wherever He leads.

Seek the King's glory through Praise and Worship: End your time of prayer with praise and worship. Thank God for His goodness, and bless in the name of Jesus all who come to your mind today.
