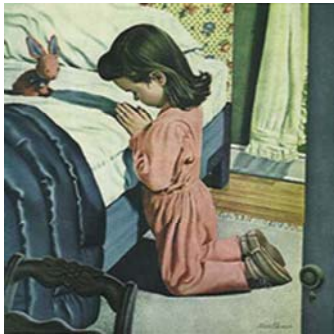


- 26) That they will be truly humble.
